**Re: Future Airline Premium Lounge Space in the new  
Bradley West Central Core**

As we begin construction of the new Bradley West Modernization Program, which is intended to begin operation by 12/12/12, it is time to initiate discussion among the TBIT Airlines regarding where each of the airline alliances or non aligned airlines may want to develop airline premium lounges.

In order to help facilitate that discussion, we have developed a package for your review and information. The package includes:

**1. Briefing Paper**

- The briefing paper begins to address the process of determining options for the airline premium lounges and their locations.
- It is intended to provide some basic information to all TBIT Airlines so that everyone has the same information and opportunity available to them to understand options and the suggested process to follow for establishing airline premium lounge locations in the Bradley West building.

**2. Drawings**

- The drawings show the locations of these future spaces for the airline premium lounges on the 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> floors of the new Bradley West Central Core.
- The drawings also show some potential opportunities for expansion of the existing lounges.

**3. Preliminary Schedule**

- The schedule indicates the steps from today to 12/12/12, which is the opening date for the Bradley West Modernization.
- In order for the airlines and LAWA to have the airline premium lounges ready for passenger use on the opening, the process needs to begin soon.
- The schedule indicates two key milestone dates, the first, later this year, of when the airlines should have a preliminary understanding of their locations, and the second is when construction of the airline lounges should begin and be complete.

Hopefully this package will assist in developing an equitable, mutually acceptable process of determining airlines premium lounge locations in the new Bradley West building.
